Your Building has a New Recycling Center.

Now recycling is easier than ever because you can do it right at home — at the new recycling bins in your building. Recyclable items may vary from building to building. Check the list at right, then ask your manager or look for postings that will tell you which recyclables are being collected at your address.

A Staggering Statistic.

Each day, 35,000 tons of waste are disposed of in Los Angeles County. That's about 11 million tons of waste per year, or enough trash to fill Dodger Stadium every 11 days.



Landfill Space is Shrinking.

With nearby landfill space decreasing on a daily basis, the price of disposing of our solid waste will continue to rise. Through recycling, we actually divert waste from landfills and become less dependent on them.

Potential Recyclables in Your Building.

Aluminum & tin cans
Glass bottles & jars
Newspaper
Mixed paper, including

- Cardboard
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Telephone books

All plastics #1 & #2, including:

- Plastic milk & water jugs
- Plastic 2-liter soda bottles
- Plastic butter & yogurt tubs
- Detergent bottles
- Bleach bottles
- Aspirin bottles
- Shampoo bottles
