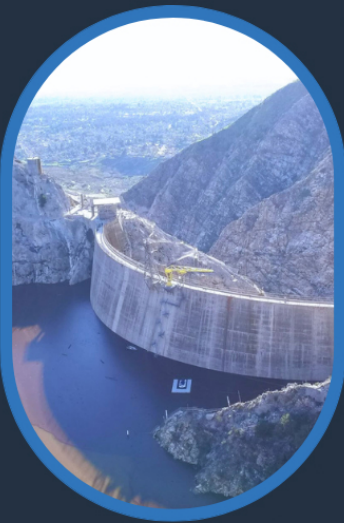


PACOIMA RESERVOIR RESTORATION PROJECT



Pacoima Reservoir provides crucial water supply and flood protection for millions of Angelenos.

Excess sediment buildup from recent wildfires has impacted its ability to serve these critical functions. Removal of this buildup is needed to ensure the continued safety and protection of local homes from future extreme weather, as well as help to capture precious water for future use.

CONTINUOUS COMMUNITY FEEDBACK: A PRIORITY

- The Project is in the early planning stage and exact details are still being assessed and determined.
- Community members will be able to provide ongoing input into the Project elements as they are developed over the next few years and they are welcome to submit comments at any time.
- Additionally, community members will be able to share comments on the Draft Program Environmental Report, tentatively scheduled for review in late 2024.

The proposed Project is tentatively scheduled to start in late 2025 and aims to remove at least 5.5 million cubic yards of sediment over the course of two phases.
