Background

Fire Name: Tujunga Fire
Date of Fire: April 27, 2007
Burned Area: 12 acres
Location: South side of Big Tujunga Canyon Road in the City of Los Angeles. Refer to Thomas Guide Page 503-H1 (2003 Edition). The burned area boundary is plotted on Attachment A.

Summary of Potential Sediment Impact

On May 17, 2007, Water Resources Division staff conducted a field reconnaissance of the burned area looking for residences and/or County facilities that could be potentially impacted by flooding/debris flows during storms. During a design storm event (50-year frequency), mudflow from the small burned hillside will spread and deposit sediment on a flat area at the toe of the hillside. The sediment deposition is unlikely to spread into the County maintained Big Tujunga Canyon Road. There are no County drainage facilities or residences that could be impacted by debris flow.
